Of the performances, I was particularly moved by Jana Haimsohn, whose sputter of vocalization and convulsive gestures metamorphosed from images of animal sounds to speaking in tongues to a state of possession by the soul of a baby shot, along with other children and women, by soldiers. Haimsohn's control in rendering utter loss of control was impressive.
